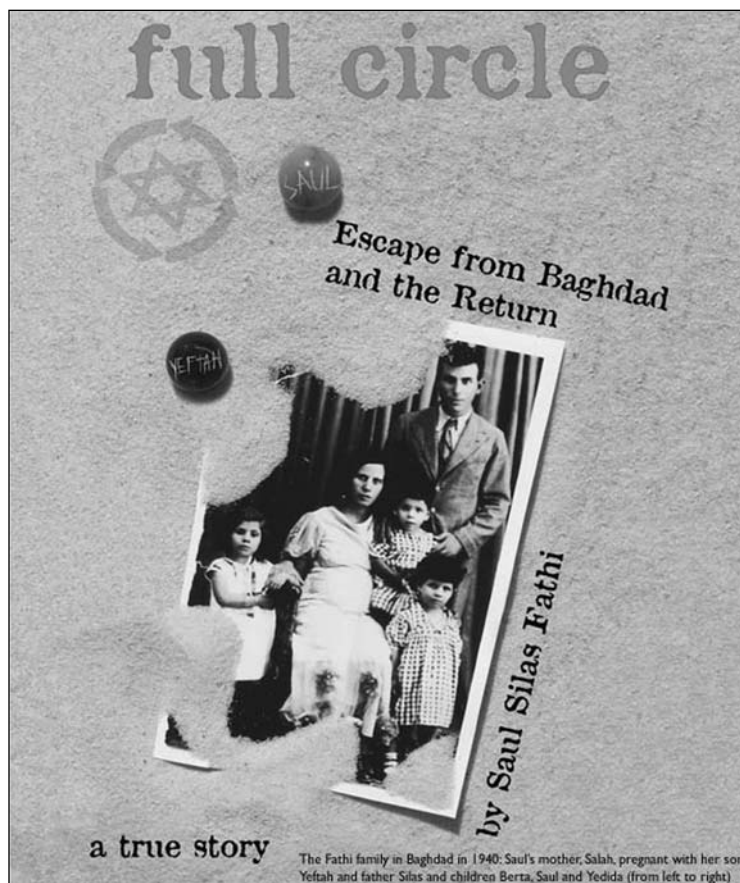
executive working for many Fortune-500 companies.
